Major was made possible by a generous gift from Central Carolina Bank to Liberty Arts Inc.

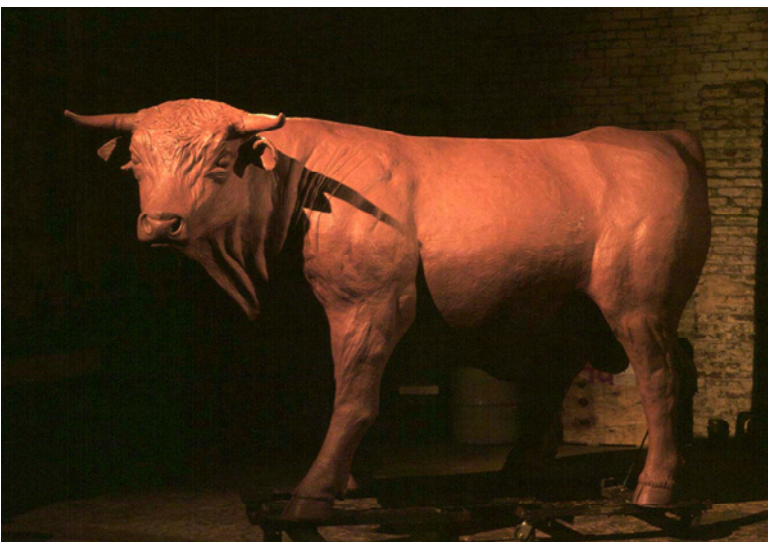

Major was designed, sculpted and fabricated by Liberty Arts artists Michael Waller and Leah Foushee. The artists started with a small maquette bull, and scaled the piece up to monumental size. The entire process was performed at Liberty Arts' studio and casting facility in the George Watts Hill Pavilion for the Arts in Durham.
